Three incumbents, led by Mayor Barbara Mouton, and two newcomers to politics were victors in Tuesday's City Council election in East Palo Alto.

Winning with Mouton were two members of her slate, incumbents Ruben Abrica and James Blakey Jr.

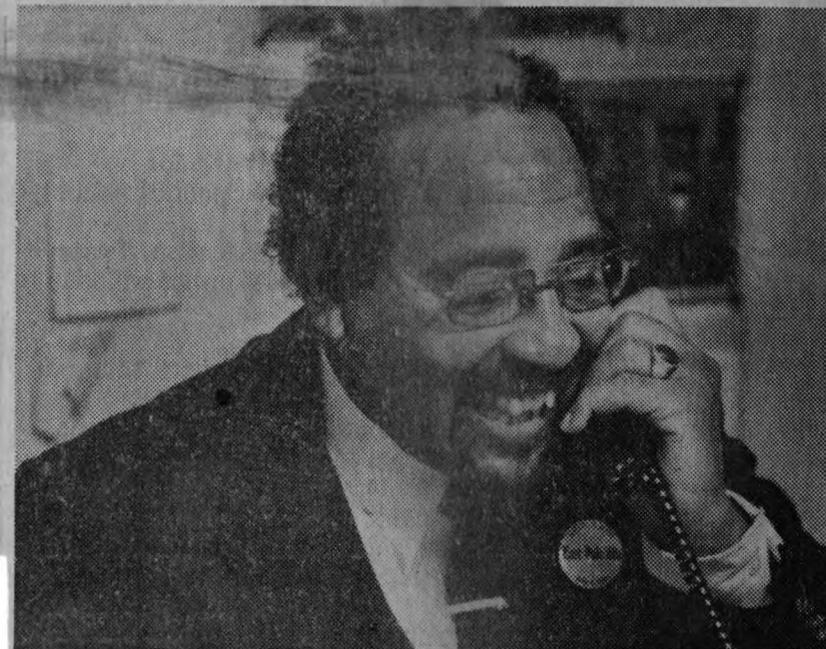
The newcomers are John Bostic and Warnell Coats, both victors in their first try for the council.

Councilwoman Gertrude Wilks, top vote-getter in the 1983 election,

failed to win re-election.

Voters again approved Measure A, the rent-control ordinance, by a substantial vote of 1,550 to 1,093. The 57.6 percent majority was less than the 64 percent vote for rent control recorded in 1985.
