SUMMARY OF ELECTION ISSUES

The following election issues were identified at the regular EPACCI meeting on April 27, 1982.

I. Public Information

A. EPACCI Literature

- The contents should focus more on the issues raised by the opposition;
- Literature should be distributed with voter's names and hand delivered;
- Literature issued near the election should concentrate on the weakest arguments of the opposition;
- 4. Literature should be translated into Spanish;
- 5. Literature on key issues should be distributed earlier;
- 6. Literature should be more credible for voters.

B. Posters and Signs

- Put up more signs in general locations;
- 2. Post more signs in yards and homes.

C. News Media

- 1. Work to maintain media support;
- 2. Work to change community image in the media.

II. Mobilization

A. Block Meetings

- 1. Identify Block captains on each street;
- Do more door-to-door canvassing;
- Have more personal contact with voter/block meetings;
- 4. Form block clubs for incorporation.

B. EPACCI Involvement

- Send flyers announcing meetings;
- 2. Reactivate those who have dropped out;
- 3. Contact local power-brokers (ministers, business persons, youth, etc.).

C. Voter Registration

- Register new voters;
- 2. Communicate frequently with new voters;
- 3. Get new voters to the polls.

III. Election

A. Candidates

- 1. Urge candidates to push incorporation first;
- 2. Prevent candidacies from disrupting EPACCI.

B. Ballot Measure

- 1. Eliminate condition that districts must be dissolved for incorporation;
- 2. Simplify ballot measure.
