The East Palo Alto Citizens' Committee on Incorporation (EPACCI) received a copy of your memorandum to the Board of Supervisors dated 2/17/81, subject "East Palo Alto Incorporation Issues".

I would like to call the following to your attention:

1. The name of our organization is the East Palo Alto Citizens' Committee on Incorporation, not East Palo Alto Community Committee on Incorporation, as cited in your memorandum.
2. The Institute for the Study of Community Economic Development (ISCED) has been commissioned by the EPACCI to provide technical assistance in the preparation of technical documents pertaining to the incorporation of East Palo Alto. Mr. Major Pugh, Director of ISCED's Community Development Institute, and Dr. Omowale Satterwhite, President of ISCED, participated in the two recent meetings held with Jay Gellert and others representing ISCED on behalf of EPACCI.
3. Mrs. Carmaleit Oakes, Convenor of EPACCI, will officially represent the citizens' committee in subsequent meetings and there will be continuing participation by ISCED staff.

EPACCI is encouraged by the active interest of your office in the incorporation of East Palo Alto. We anticipate that your office will give incorporation the necessary priority to ensure completion of the tasks outlined in your memorandum according to schedule.
