LABOR DAY 1968

The East Palo Alto Community was graced by the San Mateo County Black Action Conference during the Labor Day weekend 1967.

The Conference was historic in many aspects:

It was the first Black Conference that came together to focus on specific local issues.

It was the largest gathering of Black People in the histor of San Mateo County.

It was free of incidents with the police (thanks to BCRA).

It involved Black People of all statuses that Black People occupy; i.e., doctors, lawyers, educators, trustees, commissioners, laborers, unemployed, radicals, moderates, conservatives, etc. etc.
