I AM OUTRAGED at the dirty political activities surrounding rent control. I am a homeowner and the mother of five future renters. I believe in fair rent control. I have read and agree with the present rent sentee landlords are obtaining signatures ordinance now in effect.

I have personally been approached by four different people soliciting signatures. None of them had read the rent ordinance or attended a single City Council meeting. None of them was aware that there was a rent ordinance. During my last encounter with one of these solicitors I was physically

What they fail to realize is the city of East Palo Alto already has a rent ordinance with a rent stabilization board to interpret and enforce it.

It bothers me that money is a primary incentive for a large percentage of those people soliciting signatures. Many are unemployed and honestly need the money.

It bothers me that people in power are playing upon the ignorance of black people using tactics practiced during slavery. I love my people. It hurts to see many of us misled by absentee landlords working in their own best interests to become multimillionaires taking advantage of the poor and ignorant.

It bothers me that intelligent but misinformed people signed the rent ordinance petition without reading it.
