"ACQUISITION OF RAVENSWOOD HIGH SCHOOL SITE"

WHEREAS, the RAVENSWOOD RECREATION PARK DISTRICT, the EAST PALO ALTO MUNICIPAL COUNCIL, and the RAVENSWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT authorized a joint task force and relevant executives to explore acquisition of the RAVENSWOOD HIGH SCHOOL SITE; and

WHEREAS, the RAVENSWOOD RECREATION PARK DISTRICT, the EAST PALO ALTO MUNICIPAL COUNCIL, and the RAVENSWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT have considered resulting information on the ownership, use, and operation of the RAVENSWOOD HIGH SCHOOL upon its acquisition; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the respective organizations have agreed to request the District Attorney's Office to draft a joint powers agreement for review by all relevant bodies; and

WHEREAS, it was further the agreement of said representatives that such a joint powers agreement would be an integral part of the bidding process necessary to acquire the site;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all relevant bodies agree on the substance of a joint powers agreement with regard to the ownership, use, and operation of the site upon its acquisition to include, at least, the following:

1. Ownership of the building by Ravenswood City School District and ownership of land by Ravenswood Recreation Park District;

2. Maintenance and operation of building primarily by Ravenswood City School District with contributions as appropriate by others;
3. Maintenance and operation of land primarily by Ravenswood Recreation Park District with contributions as appropriate by other bodies;
4. A covenant on Ravenswood City School District ownership of the building which requires use of the building by Ravenswood Recreation Park District for office space and programs as mutually agreed upon between Ravenswood City School District and Ravenswood Recreation Park District.

Regularly passed and adopted this 28 day of June, 1979.
