Fireworks

The East Palo Alto Police
Department would like to wish
everyone a happy and safe new
year. With your safety in mind
we would also like to remind
everyone that fireworks are not
legal in East Palo Alto. Fireworks
are not only illegal, they are also
dangerous. Here are some facts:

- Every year dangerous and illegal items such as cherry bombs, m-80s and firecrackers cause numerous injuries to both adults and children and illegal bottle rockets cause thousands of dollars in property damage.
- Parents may be held liable for any damages or injuries caused by their children's use of illegal fireworks.

- Possession and- or use of illegal fireworks is a misdemeanor punishaable by a fine not less than \$500 or more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment in the county jail for up to one year or both
 - Possession of illegal fireworks that collectively contain in excess of 7,500 grains of powder (approximately one pound) is a felony punishable by imprisonment in (1) a state prison; or (2) a county jail for up to one year; and/or a fine not to exceed \$5,000.
- Hospital emergency rooms in the United States treat nearly 10,000 fireworks related injuries each year, with 45 percent of these injuries occurring among children under the age of 15.
- Fireworks can result in serious injuries such as burns, fractures, lifetime disfigurement or death.

Don't Drink and Drive I

Remember not to drink and drive when you are celebrating the new year. The greater the blood alcohol concentration, the greater the risk of being involved in a fatal crash.
