B. POSSIBLE WORKSHOP DISCUSSION ITEMS

- Major types of physical development to be encouraged.
- Development goals & objectives for the 1980's.
- Specific development policies.
- Implementation actions to be taken.
- Changes, additions or deletions to the Preliminary Draft Plan.
- Comments on issues such as: housing, transportation, employment, commercial development, industrial development, agriculture, noise, urban design, schools, parks, environmental quality, utilities & overall land use.

C. DEFINITIONS

- GOAL - The ultimate, long term purpose of the plan stated in a general way. Example: 'Maintain a convenient, effective and efficient transportation system.'
- OBJECTIVE - A goal that can be measured. Example: 'Reduce peak-hour traffic congestion to service level 'c' by 1985.'
- POLICY - A specific statement guiding action and implying clear commitment. Example: 'Reduce traffic impacts from the new Dumbarton Bridge on the community.'
- ACTION - A procedure or activity to help carry out a policy. Example: 'Coordinate development of alternative access routes to the Dumbarton Bridge with State, regional and local agencies.'
