

Old Swim Hole to Vanish

Report on progress of the destruction of an old swimming hole used by Palo Alto Park residents since World War I, will be made tonight (Thursday) at a meeting of the Palo Alto Park Property Owners Association.

Mrs. Walter Werby, publicity chairman said that leveling of the 75 by 175 foot hole is being accomplished by Gillespie Bros., EPA contractors. The swimming hole, which is adjacent to PA water company property was closed approximately four years ago when the new recreation district pool was opened. It lacks necessary filtration.

Built by members of the cavalry in World War I, the old swimming hole was once the center of activity in the area.

Members of the Property Owners Association are paying costs of demolition and will install a needed sump as soon as leveling is completed. They plan to restore the area as a recreation center, Mrs. Werby said.

Association members will meet at the water company office, 2190 Addison street, at 8 p.m.
