

# NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CIRCULATE RECALL PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE WARNELL COATS:

Pursuant to Section 27020, California Elections Code, the undersigned, registered qualified voters of the City of East Palo Alto, State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we seek your recall and removal from the office of City Council Member in City of East Palo Alto, California.

The grounds for the proposed recall are as follows:

On October 11, 1990 the County Board of Elections reported that 2,233 East Palo Alto citizens signed the PETITION TO RECALL WARNELL COATS! A random sampling of 500 signatures found 28.6% invalid. The Recall Committee reviewed these invalidated signatures, personally recognizing most of them. However, Article 3 Section 3520(a) of the California Election Code states:

Once filed no petition section shall be amended except by order of a court of competent jurisdiction. Since the court process is long and costly, we are recirculating the Petition.

The basic charges are the same:

- violating city ordinances
- violating environmental laws
- participating in illegal meetings

and destroying the moral and political fiber which affords us a decent place to live in.

Additional charges are:

- Coats supports and advanced the proposal to build a gambling casino in our City.
- Coats voted that a toxic waste plant expansion here is exempt from environmental laws.
- Coats supports the landlords' proposal for condominium conversions to destroy rent control and affordable housing in this community.

We incorporate by reference the complete Notice of Intent which was served on you in June, 1990.
