Dear East Palo Alto resident:

As you are probably aware, the Local Agency Formation Commission, on which I serve, is currently holding public hearings on a number of important issues affecting the future of the unincorporated area known as East Palo Alto, including your "neighborhood" which is west of Bayshore and north of Euclid Avenue.

Background - After lengthy hearings in 1981, LAFCo placed this "neighbor-hood" within the sphere of influence of Menlo Park, thus removing it from the proposed boundaries of the incorporated city of East Palo Alto, and designating it for future annexation to Menlo Park.

<u>Current</u> - The citizens' committee advocating the incorporation of East Palo Alto has submitted petitions from your "neighborhood" requesting LAFCo to amend the sphere of influence to include the North of Euclid area within an incorporated city of East Palo Alto, should the incorporation take place following a new election. To assist the Commission in making a decision on this application, please complete and return the enclosed post card*. Thank you.
