Supports for the single parent who has the sole responsibility of raising his/her family. In our community, there are several thousand female-headed households (there has been no count of the male-headed ones). These mothers must, of necessity, work to feed their children. They are very tired when they arrive home after work but must still attend to things for their families - cooking, washing clothes, bathing children, et cetera. When crises arise, they have literally no one to turn to for advice or help. At the present time, there is no place for them to leave their little children if they have to go to the doctor's or to the market to do the weekly grocery shopping.

Incorporation - By incorporating East Palo Alto, we can have a much greater degree of control over our own resources (monetary, work force - i.e. police, public works department, recreation department. We can decide what our priorities will be and how we will attempt to resolve them. We can take care of business right here in our own community.
