


Dear Dr. Syrtiller:

In August 1978 you forwarded to my office a letter with petitions attached requesting the construction of sidewalks on Dumbarton Avenue. Your request has not been forgotten!

I have not corresponded with you or your neighbors earlier because the matter of street and sidewalks in the portion of the community in which you reside was being informally discussed by the Council's staff with regard to making a recommendation to the Council for subsequent action.
