Item #03 Request that the Board of Supervisors initiate by resolution a proposal for incorporation of East Palo Alto, including the dissolution and merger of the East Palo Alto Sanitary District, the East Palo Alto Waterworks District, the East Palo Alto Park and Recreation District, and County Service Area No. 5 (East Palo Alto Citizens' Committee on Incorporation).

COUNCIL POSITION - Council has previously supported efforts to incorporate East Palo Alto, although they have not taken a formal position on this particular item scheduled before the Board.

Item #13 Adoption of urgency ordinance regulating video games in the unincorporated areas of the County and waiver of reading the ordinance in its entirety (Continued from April 13, 1982).

COUNCIL POSITION - The Council has not reviewed or taken a position on this item, although individual Council members have discussed it.
