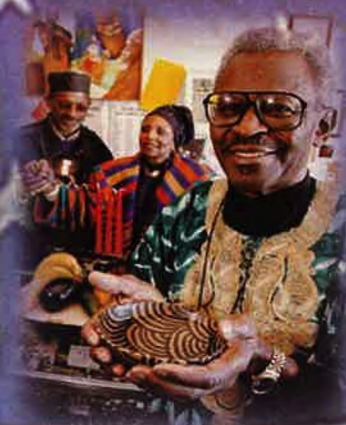

## EAST PALO ALTO

**E**ast Palo Alto, separated from the majority of The County by Highway 101 and vast ethnic and economic differences, has been struggling for self-sufficiency since its incorporation in 1983.

To afford its own police force, repair streets and maintain its parks, the city is trying to develop its economic base.

A major regional shopping center called the Ravenswood Retail Center is growing on the site of the closed Ravenswood High School. And the Ravenswood Industrial Area, contaminated by paint and plating shops, nurseries, and auto wrecking and storage facilities, will cost a few million dollars to clean up before redevelopment can begin.
