

TEEN SUMMER PROJECT PLANNED

The MEE and the EPA Day School will conduct a Summer Teen - Community Action/Education project which proposes to employ 121 teenagers from East Bayshore in creative activities on behalf of their community.

The program emphasizes education, community involvement, renewal, and unity. The students will be divided into 11 groups of ten students plus one student supervisor. Each group will further be divided into still smaller groups in order to attain an optimal teaching ratio of one student to five children.

The students will be assigned to teach groups of pre-school, kindergarten and first grade children; to lead recreational

activities throughout the neighborhood; and to increase participation of adults and parents in school and civic affairs. The students will also attend classes at the EPA Day School.

The proposed budget for supplies, equipment, and the salaries of 121 students and one administrator is \$54,254. This is for a program that will involve over 600 East Bayshore youth. The MEE and the Day School are currently seeking funding of the program. Contributions are welcome.
