- If police security will be provided by your own Police Department and the officers will be armed, under New Jersey State Statues the officers must obtain approval in advance from the Colonel of the New Jersey State Police. Phone (609) (882-2000). (Normally 90 days).

It should be noted that under New Jersey State Statues armed officers are not permitted on the Casino floor without approval of the State Commission of Gaming. You may contact the NJSP DGE at (609) 441-3540.
