The voters on this ballot are making three decisions with one vote.

We muck

First, to approve a new City of Fast Palo Alto. Second, to transfer the

Recreation District to the new city. Third, to eliminate County Service Area

No. 5 which was set up to collect extra taxes for police services,

Even though every voter will not live in the new city, each vote will affect the outcome of the incorporation election (Proposition A). This Proposition must pass to establish a new City of East Palo Alto.

By setting up a new city and eliminating the many separate districts,

East Palo Alto can have better community planning and coordination of services.

Things will be better for ALL of the voters by passing Proposition D.

When East Palo Alto becomes a city, the community will control land-use, planning, and all city services. The new City Council will be responsible for all community development. It will replace the Municipal Council. The Recreation District and County Service Area No. 5 will also go out of business.

Their functions -- recreation, police services and garbage collection -- will be transferred to the new City of East Palo Alto.

Independent studies by SRI International and county consultants have shown that East Palo Alto has enough money to operate a successful city. All of the city departments, including our own police department, will operate on a sound financial basis.

Remember, these are monies that East Palo Alto NOW pays and which are spent by the county and other districts. Property taxes, by law, will not be increased by the new city.
