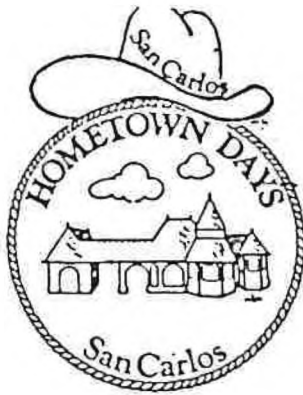


Dear Matias,
