A Report of Testing Conducted Under the Miller-Unruh Basic Reading Act 1965

The Miller-Unruh Basic Reading Act of 1965 requires each school district in California to test pupils in grades 1, 2, and 3 during May of each year. When the Act was first legislated, each district was required to use the Stanford Reading Test. Recent legislative changes have resulted in the phasing in of the Cooperative Primary Reading Test and the phasing out of the Stanford Reading Test. Therefore, this year the pupils in grades 1 were administered the Cooperative Primary Reading Test while pupils in grades 2 and 3 continued to be tested on the Stanford Reading Test. Another change that occurred for this year's testing program was the time that the tests were to be administered. In the past years the reading tests were administered during the last ten days in May. This year the school districts were required to administer the tests during the first ten school days in May.

The test results for Grade 1 showed that there was an average gain of two months from (1.7) to (1.9) for the first grades in the district. It is further significant that in each school in the district there was at least one month's growth over last year's scores. While there was an overall average of two months growth for all first graders, one school (Flood) made five months growth and two other schools (Belle Haven and Runnymede) made three months growth over previous years. It is also significant that since the testing occurred during the first ten days of May the national norm for first graders at this time would be 1.8 and since the average for the Ravenswood School District's first graders is 1.9, first grade children are achieving one month above the national norms (and even more above state norms).

The second grade students were administered the Stanford Reading Test and

their results showed an average of two months growth for the district over last year's results. Each school made at least one month's growth over last year's results. One school (Belle Haven) made six months growth over last year. Another school (Willow) made five months growth while two additional schools (Kavanaugh and Flood) made, on the average, four months growth over last year. Not only did the children make, on the average, two months more growth this year than was measured last year, but in comparison to the state norms for California the Ravenswood District is achieving one month ahead of the norms for the state.

The third grade students in the Ravenswood District were administered the Stanford Reading Test and the overall grade placement showed one month growth over last year's results. In analyzing the results of the different schools it was noted that there was a great variance among the different schools as two schools, Belle Haven and Costano, showed an average decrease in their achievement for this year as compared to last year's results. On the other hand, two other schools (Brentwood and Runnymede) showed great gains when comparing the average results for this year to the average result of last year. Although the district showed an average gain of one month between this year's results as compared to last year's results, it is still functioning approximately three months below the state norms for this grade level. (see introductory statement)

In comparing the reading results for this school district over the last three years one sees a noticeable change in an upward direction which is quite prevalent in the first two grades and is only slightly noticeable in the third grade. These results may be a reflection of the district's adoption of Lippincott as its basic reading program, for this program is currently being used in grades 1 and 2 and will be introduced in the third grades during the 1970-71 school year.
