

# Ravenswood out of section tourney

Ravenswood's All-Stars scored a run in the top of the first inning Tuesday night, but it was all downhill from there as Ravenswood lost to Hartnell of Salinas at Santa Clara's Steve Carli Field, 15-2, in the Little League Section 3 All-Star Tournament.

The loss knocked Ravenswood out of the double-elimination baseball tournament. Ravenswood had lost to Watsonville, 8-6, in a first-round game Saturday.
